Following this, astronauts will land on the lunar surface during the Artemis III mission, slated for mid-2027.

#### GOVERNMENT UPDATES

Assistant secretary of state for South and Central Asian affairs Donald Lu visited India, Sri Lanka, and Nepal from December 03, 2024, to December 10, 2024. United States and India concluded the latest East Asia consultations on December 04, 2024. U.S. and Indian officials engaged in discussions to strengthen collaboration between the state department's office of China Coordination (CH) and India's Centre for Contemporary China Studies (CCCS). The meeting emphasized continued cooperation under the CH-CCCS memorandum of understanding.
